



Terms and Conditions:

With this registration form, please attach a **non-refundable** deposit of 'half' the camp fee for each camp the student is attending.

Please note: Student is not registered until deposit has been paid.

The remainder of fees must be paid on or before the first day of camp. Fees may be paid through your agent or deposited directly to IMAGINA financial institution. Banking information will be given upon request.

1. Enrollment

All enrollments are subject to the following conditions, which become legally binding on acceptance of enrollment by IMAGINA Camp. All fees must be paid in full before your program begins. We will confirm your enrollment in writing through your agent or by fax or email.

2. Services

The IMAGINA Camp reserves the right to change services and program agenda where circumstances beyond the Camp's control necessitate such changes.

3. Visa

All students must have a valid passport and a letter from BOTH of their parents or guardians stating that they have been given permission to travel to Mexico for this program. This letter must be notarized in order to be official. Students arriving without this document may be sent back by the Mexican customs and immigration service, with no refund of the program price.

You need to go to a Mexican consulate abroad to ask about the requirements and to take the necessary steps to get your visa. The requirements differ from country to country.

If you are a citizen of Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, San Marino, Singapore, Slovenia, Spain, South Korea, Sweden, Switzerland, United States of America, Uruguay or Venezuela, you don't need a visa to enter Mexico, although you must present a valid passport and fill out an immigration form for tourists' trips, which can be obtained in travel agencies, airlines or at the point where you enter Mexico.

The immigration officer at your point of entry into Mexico can also request that you demonstrate that you have sufficient funds and a return ticket to your country.

If you are a citizen of any other country, you need to go to a Mexican consulate to request a visa. If you have a family member, friend or acquaintance in Mexico, he or she can do this at the INM.

Consult the requirements or go to any of the INM delegations throughout Mexico for detailed information about requesting a visa. Remember that you are flying to the **United States so you need also to have the appropriate documents for their visa.**

4. Medical Insurance:

All students attending IMAGINA Camp must have the appropriate medical and health insurance. Students must provide proof of such insurance 2 weeks prior to attending. (Proof may be emailed to the camp or agent)
